STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section 62 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes relating to deposit of state funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 62 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Statutes is hereby 2 amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in 3 place thereof the following:

'Sect. 62. The treasurer may deposit the moneys of the 2 state in any of the banking institutions or trust companies 3 organized under the laws of this state or in any national

4 bank or banks located therein. Not exceeding twenty-five

5 per cent of its capital stock and surplus shall be deposited

6 in any one such bank or institution. The above restriction

7 shall not apply to deposits actually made to meet the pay-

8 ment of any bonded debts or interest or warrants of the

9 Governor and Council.'
