STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT relating to the issuing of blank writs by clerks of the supreme judicial courts, clerks and recorders of municipal and police courts and trial justices.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Clerks of the supreme judicial courts, clerks and recorders

- 2 of the municipal and police courts and trial justices of the
- 3 state shall not sell or deliver any blank writs or precepts
- 4 bearing the seal of said courts and the signature of said
- 5 clerks, recorders and trial justices, to any person except
- 6 one who has been admitted as an attorney and counselor

7 at law, and solicitor and counselor in chancery in accord-8 ance with the laws of this state.
