STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to fix the time of payment of salaries of county officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The salaries of judges of probate, registers of 2 probate, clerks of judicial courts, sheriffs, county commis-3 sioners, registers of deeds and county treasurers of the sev-4 eral counties, shall be paid in equal monthly payments on the 5 last day of each month.

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the 2 provisions of this act are hereby repealed.
