STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to grant certain powers to Acadia Landing.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The incorporation of Acadia Landing, organ-2 ized under the general law, September 23, 1889, is hereby 3 ratified and confirmed.

Sect. 2. The stockholders of said Acadia Landing are 2 hereby authorized by vote, at a meeting called for the pur-3 pose, to alter and amend the purposes of the corporation 4 so as to permit any person unanimously approved by the 5 directors of the corporation to become a member of and 6 stockholder therein, and to acquire and hold not exceeding 7 six shares of said stock, provided that a certificate showing 8 such amended purposes shall be approved by the attorney 9 general and recorded, as provided by law in the case of 10 original certificates of organization.
