STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to confirm and make clear certain powers of the Bangor Railway and Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Bangor Railway and Electric Company, a corporation

- 2 organized under the general laws of the state of Maine as
- 3 the Old Town Electric Company, the name of which was
- 4 changed to Bangor Railway and Electric Company by Chap-
- 5 ter forty-six of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen
- 6 hundred and five, is hereby granted the same right and
- 7 power to convey persons and property over all its street
- 8 railroad lines that is conferred upon street railroads by sec-
- 9 tion two of chapter fifty-eight of the Revised Statutes of 10 nineteen hundred sixteen.
