STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to amend Section two of chapter five of the Revised Statutes relating to qualification of voters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter five of the Revised

- 2 Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "male"
- 3 in the fourth line thereof.
 - Sect. 2. All other public laws and statutes pertaining to
- 2 elections shall be construed to apply to both males and
- 3 females.
 - Sect. 3. This act shall take effect only upon the adoption

- 2 in Spetember, nineteen hundred seventeen, of the proposed
 3 amendment extending the right of suffrage to women, and
 4 in case of such adoption, shall take effect on the day said
- 5 constitutional amendment becomes effective.
