STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Twenty of Chapter One Hundred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Department of Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty of chapter one hundred seventeen of the

- 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words
- 3 "eighteen hundred" in the tenth line thereof and substitut-
- 4 ing in place thereof the words 'two thousand' so that said
- 5 section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 20. The state superintendent of public schools 2 shall receive an annual salary of four thousand dollars.

3 He shall also receive his actual cash expenses incurred in 4 the performance of his official duties, which shall be paid 5 out of a specific appropriation for that purpose. He shall 6 employ a chief clerk who may serve as his deputy and such 7 other clerical assistance as the governor and council may 8 deem necessary. The chief clerk in the office of the state 9 superintendent of public schools shall receive an annual 10 salary of two thousand dollars; he shall also receive his 11 necessary expenses when on official business within the state.'
