STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to legalize the doings of the inhabitants of the Town
of Windham at the annual town meeting held on March 5th,
A. D. 1917, and by adjournment, on March 7th, A. D. 1917.

WHEREAS an emergency exists, because it is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace and safety, that the acts and doings of the inhabitants of the Town of Windham at the annual town meeting, held on March 5th, A. D. 1917, and by adjournment, on March 7th, A. D. 1917, be made legal and valid without delay, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The acts and doings of the inhabitants of the
2 Town of Windham in the County of Cumberland at the an-
3 nual town meeting held at the town-house in said town on
4 Monday, March 5th, A. D. 1917, and by adjournment, on
5 Wednesday, March 7th, A. D. 1917, are hereby confirmed,
6 legalized and made valid.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
