STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

AN ACT to Provide for the Establishment of a Bureau of Markets and to Provide for Marketing Farm Products and Purchasing Farm Supplies.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The commissioner of agriculture is hereby authorized to

- 2 expend the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars an-
- 3 nually hereafter to study the methods and cost of marketing
- 4 farm products and purchasing farm supplies, by employing
- 5 agents and experts who shall work in conjunction with the
- 6 Farmers' Union of Maine, the Fruit Growers' Association,
- 7 and other farm organizations.
