IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND SEVENTEEN

RESOLVE, in favor of the Appointment of the Hydro-Electric Power Investigating Committee.

Resolved: That a committee be appointed consisting of
2 two members on the part of the Senate and three on the
3 part of the House, to be known as the Hydro-Electric Power
4 Investigating Committee, who shall serve without compen-
5 sation other than their actual expenses. It shall be the duty
6 of this Committee to get the facts in relation to our water
7 powers and hydro-electrical development in this state. This
8 committee shall hold at least one public hearing in each of
9 the following cities: Portland, Lewiston, Augusta and

10 Bangor, giving due notice thereof, for the purpose of hearing
11 any one interested in these questions, and that a sum not ex-
12 ceeding five thousand (\$5000.00) dollars, shall be, and here-
13 by is appropriated to pay the expenses of this committee,
14 and said committee shall make their report to the next legis-
15 lature
