### STATE OF MAINE

# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section 29 of Chapter 18 of the Revised Statutes Relating to the State Board of Dental Examiners.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 29 of chapter 18 of the revised statutes is hereby
2 amended by inserting after the word "certificate" in the
3 third line thereof the words 'of ability' and by adding at
4 the end of said section 29 the following:

'Said certificate shall be considered a license to practice 2 dentistry in this state, except that it shall be unlawful for 3 any person to practice dentistry in this state in any year 4 after the year in which said certificate is issued to him un-5 less he shall pay to the treasurer of the state board of den-

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6 tal examiners on or before January 1st of said year a fee 7 of one dollar for which he shall receive a registration card, 8 which card shall be placed beside or attached to the certifi-9 cate above mentioned,' so that said section, as amended, 10 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 29. Certificate under seal; to be displayed. 1913, 2 c. 53, sections 8, 16. Said board shall issue under its seal, 3 to all persons who shall successfully pass said examination, 4 its certificate of ability to practice dentistry in this state 5 signed by its president and secretary. Whoever engages 6 in the practice of dentistry in this state shall keep his cer-7 tificate in a conspicuous place in the operating room or 8 rooms in which he practices. Said certificate shall be con-9 sidered a license to practice dentistry in this state, except IO that it shall be unlawful for any person to practice dentistry II in this state in any year after the year in which said cer-12 tificate is issued to him unless he shall pay to the treasurer 13 of the state board of dental examiners on or before January 14 1st of said year a fee of one dollar for which he shall re-15 ceive a registration card, which card shall be placed beside 16 or attached to the certificate above mentioned.'

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
