STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE. In favor of building a road in the town of Eagle Lake to open farm lands for settlement.

Resolved: That the sum of \$500 be appropriated to aid in
2 building a road in the town of Eagle Lake for the purpose
3 of opening farm lands for settlement.

Providing that there be appropriated by the town of Eagle
3 Lake the sum of \$500 for the purpose. Providing also that
4 the county of Aroostook shall furnish an equal sum of \$500
5 for the same purpose. All money to be expended under the
6 supervision of the State Highway Department and the
7 County Commissioners.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The town of Eagle Lake has built within the last four years one mile of this road in a very satisfactory condition.

To do this the town has appropriated each year five hundred dollars (\$500), making a total of two thousand dollars (\$2000).

There are already six inhabitants who have taken farms there and lots more good farms to be taken by some of our boys who are coming home from France or some other young men who would like to try their luck in farming.
