STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend section twenty-one of chapter seven of the Revised Statutes relating to the time of the opening and Closing of Polls at Elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-one of chapter seven of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by striking out the word "five" in the fourth line thereof, and substituting in place, the word 'six' so that the section as amended shall read as follows:

'Meetings for the election of state and county officers, and for the election of municipal officers in cities, may be opened

3 at six o'clock in the forenoon, and shall be opened not later
4 than ten o'clock in the forenoon; the polls shall be kept open
5 until six o'clock in the afternoon and shall then be closed.
6 Notice of the time of opening and closing shall be given in
7 the warrant calling the meeting.'
