STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT for the protection of Clams within the limit of the Capitol Island Village Corporation in the County of Lincoln.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No clams shall be taken from the shores and

- 2 flats within the limit of the Capitol Island Village Corpora-
- 3 tion, excepting that any one person may take or dig not
- 4 exceeding one peck of clams at any one tide, for any one
- 5 family.

Sect. 2. Any person taking clams contrary to the pro-

- 2 visions of this act shall be punished for each offence by a
- 3 fine not exceeding one dollar.
