IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the Register of Deeds,
Register of Probate and Clerk of Courts for Two Years.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That during the full period two years from January 1,
2 1919, to December 31, 1920, the salaries of the register of
3 deeds, register of probate and clerk of courts of Lincoln
4 county, be increased by an amount equal to thirty per cent
5 of the amount of the respective salaries of these officers as
6 now fixed by law.
