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RESOLVE, authorizing the State Land Agent to sell certain lots in the town of St. Agatha in the County of Aroostook.

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Resolved: that the land agent of the state of Maine be and  
2 he hereby is authorized to sell for cash lots numbered ninety-  
3 four, ninety-five, ninety-six, ninety-seven, ninety-eight,  
4 ninety-nine, one hundred, one hundred and one, one hundred  
5 and two, one hundred and three, one hundred and four, one  
6 hundred and five, one hundred and six, one hundred and  
7 seven, one hundred and eight, one hundred and ten, in town-  
8 ship number eighteen, range five, west of the east line of the  
9 state, if he deem it advisable, for such price per acre, and  
10 on such terms of payment as he may deem advantageous.
