STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE in favor of the city of Calais to reimburse said city
for money expended in the care of state paupers.

Resolved: That there be paid to the city of Calais the
2 sum of two hundred fifty-three dollars and ninety-five cents
3 (\$253.95) to reimburse said city for money expended in the
4 care of state paupers in the years nineteen hundred thirteen
5 to nineteen hundred sixteen, both inclusive.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The city of Calais has paid the amounts set forth below to the parties named and on the dates set forth for the care of a minor child, Arthur Langmore, properly chargeable to the state as a state pauper.
