STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Regulating the Taking of Clams in the Town of
Swan's Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No clams shall be taken within the limits of
2 the town of Swan's Island by any person not residing in
3 said town where such clams are taken. This section shall
4 not interfere with any law relating to the taking of shell
5 fish for bait by fishermen.

Sect. 2. Whoever shall violate the provisions of section
2 one of this act, shall for each offense, be fined not more
3 than ten dollars, or imprisonment not more than thirty days.
