STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Authorize the Town of Southport to Rebuild and Maintain a Bridge Across Nelson's Millpond, So-called.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The town of Southport is hereby authorized to rebuild 2 and maintain a bridge across Nelson's Millpond in the 3 town of Southport from the terminal of highway leading 4 to said Nelson Millpond to private way of William T. Mad-5 docks, said bridge to be constructed and maintained in ac-6 cordance with the acts of Congress pertaining to bridges 7 and wharves extending over and across tide waters.
