STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Providing Teacher's Pension for Adelia J.
Webber.

Resolved: That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 appropriation for payment of teachers' pensions, to Adelia
3 J. Webber, of Wilton, in the County of Franklin, the sum
4 of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) per annum during
5 the lifetime of the said Adelia J. Webber, the same to be
6 in lieu of any teacher's pension which she might be entitled
7 to under the law as its now exists.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Adelia J. Webber was 60 years of age on March 13, 1918. She is a graduate of the Farmington State Normal School and has taught for 43 years. Her work has been in ungraded schools and High schools. Of the 43 years all but 8 years has been engaged in teaching in the State of Maine. For 8 years she was a teacher in the schools of Massachusetts and has been engaged since her return for 11 years in teaching in Maine.
