STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Four Hundred and One of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and One, as Amended by Chapter Three Hundred and Fifty-one of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Nine, Entitled An Act for the Protection of Salmon, Alewives and Smelts in Pleasant River, Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter four hundred and one
2 of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and one
3 as amended by chapter three hundred and fifty-one of the
4 private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine is
5 hereby amended by striking out in the third line of said
6 section one the words "five hundred yards" and inserting

7 in place thereof the words 'fifty feet'; also by striking out
8 in the third and fourth lines of said section one after the
9 word "fishway" the words 'except by hook and line or
10 hand dip net' so that said section one as amended shall read
11 as follows:

'Section 1. No person shall be allowed to take any salmon,
2 alewives or smelts in Pleasant river, Washington county,
3 within fifty feet of any dam or fishway.'

Sect. 2. Section three of said chapter is hereby amended
2 by inserting at the end thereof after the word "fishway"
3 the words 'and no salmon or alewives shall be taken or
4 fished for between the fifteenth day of September and the
5 first day of March,' so that said section three as amended
6 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. No salmon, alewives or smelts shall be fished
2 for or taken within fifty feet of any dam or fishway, and
3 no salmon or alewives shall be taken or fished for between
4 the fifteenth day of September and the first day of March.'
