RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for the Maintenance of
Teachers' Old Home, on Old Town, Indian Island, No. 1.

Resolved: That there be and thereby is appropriated the
2 sum of six hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred
3 and nineteen and the sum of six hundred dollars for the
4 year nineteen hundred and twenty for the maintenance of
5 the Teachers' Old Home on Old Town, Indian Island, No.
6 1, said sum to be expended under the direction of the gov-
7 ernor and council and the Indian Agent, by the teachers on
8 Indian Island.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The Seventy-eighth Legislature appropriated two thousand four hundred and twenty-five dollars for the renovation and furnishing of the building known as the Teachers' Old Home, situated on Indian Island, No. 1, Old Town. In October nineteen seventeen this work was completed and the house opened. At that time classes were formed and much good practical work has been accomplished. This resolve is for carrying on this work during the years nineteen hundred and nineteen and nineteen hundred and twenty.
