STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Relating to the Duties of State Officials and Employes

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Every state official or employe receiving a full-

- 2 time salary shall devote his time to the service of the state
- 3 except customary holidays and vacations and such other
- 4 leaves of absence as the Governor and Council may au-
- 5 thorize.
 - Sect. 2. No official or employe who is authorized to sign
- 2 checks for the state or for any department thereof shall
- 3 sign any such check in blank.
