## STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Provide a Penalty for Wounding or Killing a Human Being by the Negligent or Careless Driving of a Motor Vehicle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Whoever, by the negligent or careless driving of an auto2 mobile, or other motor vehicle, wounds or kills any human
3 being, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more
4 than ten years, or by fine not exceeding one thousand dol5 lars.
