STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Authorizing Michael Burns to Bring a Suit at
Law Against the State of Maine.

Resolved: That Michael Burns of Augusta in the County
2 of Kennebec and State of Maine, the respondent in criminal
3 proceedings brought by the State of Maine in eighteen
4 hundred eighty-seven for illegal sale of intoxicating liquors,
5 be and he hereby is authorized to bring a suit at law in
6 the supreme judicial court in the county of Kennebec, with-
7 in one year from the first day of October, in the year of
8 our Lord nineteen hundred nineteen, against the State of
9 Maine to recover damages sustained on account of such
10 prosecution.

The writ issuing out of said supreme judicial court under
2 the authority of this resolve shall be served on the secre-
3 tary of state by an attested copy thirty days before the
4 return thereof by the sheriff of said county or either of
5 his deputies. The conduct of said suit shall be according
6 to the practice of suits between parties in said court and
7 the attorney general is hereby authorized and designated
8 to appear and answer to said suit.

Any judgment that may be recovered in such suit shall
2 be payable from the treasury of the state of Maine on final
3 process issued by said court out of any money not other-
4 wise appropriated and costs may be taxed for the said
5 Michael Burns if he recovers in said suit. The presiding
6 justice or the jury hearing the cause may add such interest
7 as is fair and just between said Michael Burns and the
8 state of Maine.
