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AN ACT to Authorize Horace Cleland to Erect and Maintain  
a Fish Weir in Tide Waters in Front of His Land in the  
Town of Perry.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Horace Cleland, his heirs and assigns are  
2 hereby authorized to construct and maintain a fish weir in  
3 tide waters in front of his land in the town of Perry.

Sect. 2. Said weir to be situated near the mouth of Pulpit  
2 Rock Cove, so-called, and within the extension of the side  
3 lines of said Horace Cleland's land and near the extension  
4 of the division line of land between said Cleland and Nellie  
5 Goulding.
