STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Extend the Charter of the Livermore and Augusta
Railway_Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Liver-

- 2 more and Augusta Railway Company, which were granted
- 3 by chapter one hundred eighty-nine of the private and
- 4 special laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, are hereby ex-
- 5 tended for two years additional; and the persons named in
- 6 said act and their associates and successors shall have the
- 7 rights, powers and privileges that were granted to them
- 8 by said act, to be exercised by them for the same purpose
- o as specified in said act.

Sect. 2. Nothing herein contained is intended to repeal 2 or shall be construed as repealing the whole or any part 3 of any existing statute, and all the rights and duties herein 4 mentioned shall be exercised and performed in accordance 5 with all the applicable provisions of chapter fifty-five of 6 the revised statutes, and acts amendatory thereof or additional thereto.
