Resolved, That there be appropriated the sum of one  
2 hundred and eight dollars in favor of the town of Brown-  
3 field on account of damage by dogs or wild animals to  
4 sheep in said town in nineteen hundred and fifteen and  
5 nineteen hundred and sixteen.

This claim was received by the state auditor too late to be included in the bills reported by him to the legislature as required by chapter 2, section 84, revised statutes, and accordingly this resolve has been presented asking for reimbursement to the town of Brownfield for amounts paid out.
