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RESOLVE, Continuing Unexpended Balance of Appropriation Provided by Chapter Three Hundred Twenty-one of the Resolves of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen Entitled "Resolve in Favor of Aid in the Construction of a Highway Bridge across the St. John River between Fort Kent, Maine, and St. Francis, New Brunswick."

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Unexpended balance Fort Kent-St. Francis bridge, continued. Whereas, the legislature of nineteen hundred and thirteen by chapter three hundred twenty-one of the resolves of that year appropriated fifteen thousand dollars to be expended under certain conditions for the building of a bridge across the St. John river between Fort Kent, Maine, and St. Francis, and

Whereas, the legislature of nineteen hundred and fifteen by chapter two hundred and fifteen of the Resolves of that year and the legislature of nineteen hundred and seventeen by chapter one hundred and eight of the resolves of that year provided that said money should remain in the state treasury during the years nineteen hundred and seventeen and nineteen hundred and eighteen to be used for that purpose, for which it was originally appropriated during said years nineteen hundred and seventeen and nineteen hundred and eighteen, and

Whereas, all of said money was not expended but part thereof remains in the state treasury, having been transferred and credited to the state contingent fund of January first, nineteen hundred and nineteen, as provided by law, therefore be it

Resolved: That, provided the condition of said chapter 2 three hundred and twenty-one of the resolves of nineteen 3 hundred and thirteen are complied with during the years 4 nineteen hundred and nineteen and nineteen hundred and 5 twenty, so much of said money so unexpended is hereby 6 appropriated from the state contingent fund and shall re- 7 main in the state treasury during those years to be used 8 for the purpose for which it was originally appropriated 9 and shall be available for such use at any time during 10 the years nineteen hundred and nineteen and nineteen hun- 11 dred and twenty to be expended as directed under said orig- 12 inal resolve.
