STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, to appropriate money for the erection and furnishing of buildings for the Reformatory for Women at Skowhegan.

Resolved: That there be and hereby is appropriated for 2 the erection of a building for the Reformatory for Women, 3 in the year nineteen hundred and nineteen, the sum of 4 thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000), and for the erection 5 of a building for the Reformatory for Women, in the year 6 nineteen hundred twenty, the sum of thirty-five thousand

7 dollars (\$35,000); and the sum of two thousand five hun-

8 dred dollars (\$2500) for the year nineteen hundred nine-

9 teen, and the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars.
10 (\$2500) for the year nineteen hundred twenty, for furnish11 ing and equipping said buildings.
