AN ACT to amend Chapter 294 of the Public Laws of Nineteen Seventeen Relating to Seizure and Forfeiture of Vehicles Carrying Intoxicating Liquors.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 294 of the public laws of 1917 is hereby amended 2 by striking out the last sentence thereof, so that said chapter as amended shall read as follows:

‘Vehicles, not common carriers, used for illegal transportation of intoxicating liquor, may be confiscated. All 3 automobiles, trucks, wagons, boats or vessels, and vehicles of every kind, not common carriers, containing intoxicating liquors intended for illegal sale within the state,

6 found within the state in the possession or in the control  
7 of any person using them for the transportation of intox-  
8 icating liquors intended for illegal sale within the state,  
9 shall be seized by the officer seizing the liquors transported  
10 therein, shall be libeled as is provided for the libeling of  
11 intoxicating liquors and the vessels in which they are con-  
12 tained under chapter one hundred and twenty-seven of the  
13 revised statutes, and shall be declared forfeited by the  
14 court and sold in the same manner as is provided for the  
15 sale of vessels containing intoxicating liquors.'
