STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, in Aid of Navigation on the Lower Lakes.

Resolved: That the sum of two hundred dollars be and is 2 hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys in the Lower 3 Lakes, so called, to wit: North Twin Lake, North Twin 4 thoroughfare, South Twin Lake, South Twin thoroughfare, 5 Pemadumcook lake. Pemadumcook thoroughfare, Ambajejis 6 lake and Ambajejis thoroughfare, and for the maintenance 7 of the same for the year nineteen hundred and nineteen; and 8 the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for 9 the placing of buoys in said Lower lakes and for the mainte-10 nance of same for the year nineteen hundred and twenty. 11 Said buoys shall be placed at such points in said lakes and

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12 thoroughfares as will best serve the needs of navigation 13 thereon. All said moneys shall be expended under the 14 direction of the state steamboat inspectors and any part of 15 the money hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys 16 and maintenance thereof, which shall be unexpended at the 17 end of the years nineteen hundred and nineteen and nine-18 teen hundred and twenty shall revert back to the state.
