STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Cooperate with the United States Department of Agriculture, Bureau of Animal Industry, for the Purpose of Making a Tuberculin Test of All Cattle Used for Either Dairy, Breeding or Beef Purposes Within the State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Upon the taking effect of this act the live stock sanitary

2 commissioner shall proceed to cause all cattle in the state to

- 3 be subjected to the tuberculin test, said test to be governed
- 4 by the rules established by the bureau of animal industry,
- 5 United States Department of Agriculture. For the pur-
- 6 pose of making such test the state shall be divided into cer-
- 7 tain areas or districts composed either of towns, groups of

8 towns or counties as the commissioner may elect and such 9 areas or districts shall be subject to such quarantine regulations by said commissioner as are deemed sufficient to 11 protect the area which has been tested from intercourse 12 with the untested area until such time as there shall remain 13 no untested area.
