STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Relative to the Appointment of Deputy Sheriffs and Their Compensation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. The sheriffs of the several counties may appoint
2 such number of deputy sheriffs as may be necessary to per3 form the duties required by section forty-nine of chapter one
4 hundred twenty-seven of the revised statutes. Such deputies
5 shall receive from the county treasury such compensation as
6 the sheriffs shall fix, not exceeding four dollars per day.

Sect. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are 2 hereby repealed.
