STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Chapter Three Hundred and Fifty of the
Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred and Fifteen Relating to
the Employment of Women and Minors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section two of chapter three hundred and fifty of the
2 public laws of nineteen hundred and fifteen is hereby amend-
3 ed by inserting after the word "act" in line three of said
4 section the following: 'or in any bowling alley or pool
5 room,' so that said section as amended shall read as fol-
6 lows:

'Sect. 2. No minor under sixteen years of age shall be
2 employed or permitted to work in or in connection with

3 any of the establishments or occupations named in section
4 one of this act, or in any bowling alley or pool room, be-
5 fore the hour of six thirty o'clock in the morning or after
6 the hour of six o'clock in the evening of any one day.'
