STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT Amending the Charter of the People's Ferry
Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter four hundred ninety-five of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred eighty-five entitled "An Act to Incorporate the People's Ferry Company" is hereby amended by adding the following sections:

'Sect. 10. No other ferry, or steam or power boat line operating between Portland and Peak's Island shall make or maintain a landing place at Peak's Island southerly or westerly of Trefethen's landing, without the written consent of the public utilities commission.

Sect. 11. The city of Portland may raise a sum not exceeding ten thousand dollars for the following purposes :

To aid in defraying the expenses of securing adequate transportation service for passengers, freight, and vehicles by the People's Ferry Company or any other ferry line, steamboat line or power-boat line, making landings at Portland and any of the islands of Casco Bay, and for such purposes the city of Portland may enter into such contracts as the city council may determine.'
