NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

RESOLVE, Continuing Unexpended Balance of Appropria-
tion Provided by Chapter Three Hundred Twenty-one of
the Resolves of Nineteen Hundred and Thirteen, Entitled
"Resolve in Favor of Aid in the Construction of a High-
way Bridge across the St. John River between Fort Kent,
Maine, and St. Francis, New Brunswick.

Unexpended balance Fort Kent-St. Francis bridge, continued.

WHEREAS, the legislature of nineteen hundred and fif-
teen by chapter two hundred fifteen of the resolves of that year
provided that said money should remain in the state treasury
during the years nineteen hundred and fifteen and nineteen
hundred and sixteen to be used for the purpose, for which it

was originally appropriated during said years nineteen hundred and fifteen and nineteen hundred and sixteen, and

WHEREAS, the legislature of nineteen hundred and seventeen by chapter one hundred and eight of the resolves of that year provided that said money should remain in the state treasury during the years nineteen hundred and seventeen and nineteen hundred and eighteen to be used for the purpose for which it was originally appropriated during the said years nineteen hundred and seventeen and nineteen hundred and eighteen, and,

WHEREAS, all of said money was not expended but part thereof remains in the state treasury having transferred and credited to the state contingent fund on January first, nineteen hundred and nineteen as provided by law, therefore be it

Resolved: That provided the conditions of said chapter
2 three hundred and twenty-one of the resolves of nineteen
3 hundred and thirteen are complied with during the years
4 nineteen hundred and nineteen and nineteen hundred and
5 twenty, such part of said money so unexpended shall re-
6 main in the state treasury during those years to be used
7 for the purpose for which it was originally appropriated
8 and shall be available for such use until June thirtieth,
9 nineteen hundred and twenty-one, for the payment of bills
10 contracted for the same during the years nineteen hundred
11 and nineteen and nineteen hundred ad twenty to be ex-
12 pended as directed under the said original resolve.
