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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to Amend Section Forty-nine of Chapter One Hundred Seventeen of the Revised Statutes Relating to the Board of Registration in Medicine.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section forty-nine of chapter one hundred seventeen, revised statutes, is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth and fifth lines of said section the following words, "five cents a mile each way for"; also by striking out in the sixth and seventh lines of said section the words, "but in no case shall any more be paid for traveling expenses than has been actually expended;" so that as amended said section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 49. Board of Registration in Medicine. 1911, c.  
2 31, section 6. The members of the board of registration  
3 in medicine shall receive annual salaries of one hundred  
4 dollars each, except the secretary, who shall receive three  
5 hundred dollars a year; in addition each member shall re-  
6 ceive necessary traveling expenses in attending the meet-  
7 ings of the board. Extra compensation for each day ac-  
8 tually spent in investigation or prosecution of complaints  
9 and cases under section fourteen of chapter eighteen, shall  
10 be allowed to each member of the board actually engaged  
11 therein.'
