STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section Five of Chapter Ninety-six of
the Revised Statutes Relating to Notice of Foreclosure of
Mortgages of Personal Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter ninety-six of the revised statutes is
2 hereby amended by inserting after the word "service" in
3 the second line thereof, the following: 'or the official return
4 of service of any officer qualified to serve civil process,' so
5 that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 5. The notice with an affidavit of service or the
2 official return of service of any officer qualified to serve
3 civil process, or a copy of the last publication, with the
4 name and date of the paper containing it, shall be recorded

5 where the mortgage is recorded, and the copy of such
6 record is evidence that the notice has been given. If the
7 mortgagee or his assignee is not a resident of the state,
8 he shall at the time of recording such notice, record there-
9 with his appointment of an agent resident in the same town,
10 to receive satisfaction of the mortgage; and payment or
11 tender thereof may be made to him. If he does not ap-
12 point such agent, the right to redeem is not forfeited.'
