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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT Relating to Appeal of Cases from Supreme Judicial  
and Superior Courts.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

When an action now pending or hereinafter entered in  
2 either the supreme judicial court or a superior court has  
3 been tried by a jury and a verdict rendered thereon, if ver-  
4 dict is set aside and a new trial granted by the supreme judi-  
5 cial court, sitting as a court of law, on a motion for a new  
6 trial, or on an exception based on the refusal of the pre-  
7 siding justice, at any succeeding trial, shall not order a non-

8 suit in the action or direct a verdict therein, but shall sub-  
9 mit the same to the jury.
