STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND TWENTY.

AN ACT to Prevent the Denial or Abridgement of the Right to Hold Office on Account of Sex.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No citizen of the United States having a right 2 to vote in this State shall be denied this right to hold any 3 civil office under this State or any subdivision thereof on 4 account of sex.
