STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to authorize persons to vote in cities, towns and plantations from which they have changed their residences.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section 1. When any person who has complied with the
2 provisions of section two, of chapter five of the Revised
3 Statutes of nineteen hundred sixteen, desires to change his
4 residence to another city, town or plantation within the state,
5 he may notify the city clerk, or the town clerk, as the case
6 may be, of the city, town or plantation which he desires to
7 leave, of his intention to change his residence. The city
8 clerk or town clerk, as the case may be, of the city, town or

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9 plantation which said person desires to leave, shall thereto upon enter in a book for that purpose the name and resi-11 dence of the person, as they appear on the check list of the 12 said city, town or plantation, the date of the notification 13 that said person intends to change his residence, the name 14 of the city, town or plantation within the state to which 15 said person intends to change his residence; and thereafter 16 said person shall be allowed to vote in said city, town or 17 plantation which he desires to leave, until after the expira-18 tion of three months from the date of the filing of his said 19 intention with the said city or town clerk, and the board of 20 selectmen or board of registration, as the case may be, of 21 the said city, town or plantation which said person desires 22 to leave, shall not strike from the voting lists of which they 23 have the custody, the name of the said person, until after 24 the expiration of three months from the time when the said 25 person's intention was filed with the said city or town clerk. 26 Provided also, that said person's name shall not be added 27 to the voting lists of the city, town, plantation of his new 28 residence until after the expiration of three months from 29 the time when he shall have voted in the city, town or plan-30 tation of his old residence.

Sect. 2. All fines and penalties providing for the viola-2 tion of the provisions of chapter five of the revised statutes 3 of nineteen hundred sixteen shall be applicable so far as is 4 possible to violations of this act.

Sect. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith 2 are hereby repealed.
