IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND

AN ACT to enlarge the powers of Androscoggin Trust Company and to authorize said corporation to become surety on bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Androscoggin Trust Company, a corporation duly organized under the provisions of chapter ninety-six of the Public Laws of 1907, relating to the organization of trust companies, and having its place of business at Auburn, in the county of Androscoggin, is hereby authorized to become surety upon any bond required to be given by any party in any matter or proceeding in any court sitting in this State, or by any person holding any position of trust in which a bond is required.
