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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND  
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

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AN ACT to amend section twenty-six of chapter seventy of the Revised Statutes relating to the Time of Payment of Legacies.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

That section twenty-six of chapter seventy of the Revised Statutes be and hereby is amended by striking out the words "one year" in the second line of said section and inserting in place thereof the words 'eighteen months', and also by striking out all of said section after the word "will" in the second line and adding thereto the following:

'Whether there is any provision in the will as to time of payment of any legacy conflicting therewith or not.' So that said section as amended shall read as follows:

‘Legacies shall be payable in eighteen months after final  
2 allowance of the will, whether there is any provision in the  
3 will as to the time of payment of any legacy conflicting  
4 therewith or not.’
