STATEMENT OF FACTS.

During the grazing season of 1918 one cow valued at \$80 was found near Upper Pembroke dam, one steer one year old valued at \$55 was found near the outlet of Grover lake, one steer one year old valued at \$60 was found about one mile north of the air line road, all in township No. 31, Washington county, killed by bears or other wild animals. The above named cattle were the property of J. Wilbur Day.
