STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred Seventy-six of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Seventy-nine of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen Relating to the Appropriation for Teachers' Pensions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred seventy-six of chapter sixteen of the
2 revised statutes as amended by chapter seventy-nine of
3 the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen is hereby
4 further amended by striking out the word "twenty-seven"
5 in the second line thereof and substituting therefor the
6 word 'thirty' so that said section when amended shall read
7 as follows:

‘Sect. 176. For the purposes of the seven preceding sections the sum of thirty thousand dollars is annually appropriated, which sum the treasurer of state shall deduct for said purposes out of the school and mill funds and the sum so appropriated and deducted shall be denominated the school pension fund.’
