#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred Thirty-nine of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Seventy-seven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen Relating to the Appropriation for Industrial Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section one hundred thirty-nine of chapter sixteen of the 2 revised statutes as amended by chapter seventy-seven of 3 the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen is hereby 4 further amended by striking out the word "annually" in 5 the second line thereof and by striking out the words "six-6 ty-four thousand dollars" in the third line thereof and

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7 substituting therefor the words 'seventy-five thousand dol8 lars for the year nineteen hundred nineteen and eighty
9 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred twenty'
10 so that said section when amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 139. For the purposes of the seven preceding sec-2 tions there shall be deducted by the treasurer of state from 3 the school and mill fund the sum of seventy-five thousand 4 dollars for the year nineteen hundred nineteen and eighty 5 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred twenty and 6 any unexpended balance of this amount shall be added to 7 the permanent school fund. All reports required under 8 said sections shall be filed annually with the state super-9 intendent of public schools on or before the first day of 10 July, and state aid shall be payable during the month of 11 December next succeeding.'

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
