STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND
NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to Amend Section One Hundred Thirty-nine of Chapter Sixteen of the Revised Statutes as Amended by Chapter Seventy-seven of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seventeen Relating to the Appropriation for Industrial Education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one hundred thirty-nine of chapter sixteen of the 2 revised statutes as amended by chapter seventy-seven of 3 the public laws of nineteen hundred seventeen is hereby 4 further amended by striking out the word "annually" in 5 the second line thereof and by striking out the words "six- 6 ty-four thousand dollars" in the third line thereof and

7 substituting therefor the words 'seventy-five thousand dol-
8 lars for the year nineteen hundred nineteen and eighty
9 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred twenty'
10 so that said section when amended shall read as follows:

11 'Sect. 139. For the purposes of the seven preceding sec-
12 tions there shall be deducted by the treasurer of state from
13 the school and mill fund the sum of seventy-five thousand
14 dollars for the year nineteen hundred nineteen and eighty
15 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred twenty and
16 any unexpended balance of this amount shall be added to
17 the permanent school fund. All reports required under
18 said sections shall be filed annually with the state super-
19 intendent of public schools on or before the first day of
20 July, and state aid shall be payable during the month of
21 December next succeeding.'
