STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINETEEN

AN ACT to amend section thirty-eight of chapter sixteen of the Revised Statutes relating to the Duties of Superinending School Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 38 of chapter 16 of the revised Statutes is hereby

- 2 amended by striking out all of paragraph one of said section
- 3 following the word "instruction" in line three of said section
- 4 and substituting therefor the words 'and perform such other
- 5 functions as may be specified by law,' so that paragraph one
- 6 of section 38 when amended shall read as follows:
- 'I. Direct the general course of instruction and perform
- 2 such other functions as may be specified by law.'
