STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND

AN ACT to Authorize the Construction of a Weir in the Tide-
waters of Roque Harbor in the Town of Jonesport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Oscar W. Look of Jonesport, in the county of
2 Washington, is hereby authorized to build and maintain
3 a weir for fishing purposes in the tide-waters of Roque
4 Harbor in said Jonesport, providing said weir does not
5 interfere with navigation or the rights of others.

Sect. 2. The above-mentioned weir shall be located as
2 follows: The pound of weir will face the north-west, and
3 have a swing about twenty fathoms, and the easterly wing
4 to be sixty-five fathoms long, and the westerly wing to be
5 eighty-five fathoms long, running in the north-westerly
6 direction.
